Personal, social and emotional Development

We will be celebrating differences. We will build constructive and respectful relationships. We will learn about qualities and differences.

We will be looking at what makes a good friend? Discussing how we could do Random Acts of Kindness and thinking about how we look after pets/animals. We will learn strategies for staying calm in the face of frustration. Talk them through why we take turns, wait politely and tidy up after ourselves.

Physical development

We will be showing good personal hygiene including hand washing and toileting. We will be talking about the effects of exercise on our bodies. We will be following safety measures without direct supervision. Learning why we need to be safe.

We will be using a range of tools independently to develop our fine motor skills. In PE we will be developing our gross motor skills, our communication and language skills, our team work and independent thinking as we complete a variety of indoor challenges.

We will be learning about patterns and then how we can continue a pattern.

We will also be deepening our previous learning of numbers, space, shape and measure.


On the Farm

Expressive arts and design

We will be observing our natural world through real life experiences and observing various artists work.

We will be learning a range of art techniques and using a variety of art materials to make work with a desired outcome. We will be learning about colour, shape and textures. We will be using the body percussion and playing a range of instruments, listening for changing tempo and demonstrating different tempos in our own creative places.





Communication and language

Phonics

We are learning the phase 3 sounds and tricky words.

Writing

We will be continuing to practise writing our name.

Will continue writing tricky words and sounds learnt.

We will begin to develop our understanding of a sentence structure and begin to form our own independently.

Reading

We will be continuing to practise recognising our full name.
