Federation Staffing changes:

I will be leaving my post as Executive Head teacher and will be replaced by Miss Winters – who will no longer be as closely affiliated with Digby or Nocton as she will now have a position over all three schools.

Likewise Mrs Toulson will be taking up a wider ranging role rather than being linked directly with Dunston, and the same will be true of Mrs Miller and Digby.

<u>Digby</u>

Mr Hodgson has been appointed to the post of teaching in Digby. He is well known to us, having been working at Nocton throughout the year.

Mrs Miller will no longer be teaching in Gnomes as she has been recruited to the Senior Federation Lead position.

Mrs Norris has taken up a role working within the Federation to job share at both Digby and Nocton schools. At Digby she will share the teaching of Gnomes with Mrs Needham.

Mr Margarson will now be with Imps 5 days a week rather than the 4 he has been doing this year.


